14/02020 – Detached hot food takeaway at Elliotts Yard (The opening hours for the takeaway had been changed from those listed in the original Planning Application but the Parish Council had not been consulted on the change. It was agreed to write to Mr D Oliver, Chief Executive of ENC)

14/02225 – Change of Use of Jacks Green (Councillor Glithero stated that this Planning Application had been deferred until 14/10/15. It was agreed to write to Mr D Reed, Head of Planning Services of ENC expressing the Parish Councillors' concerns as below:--

1. We had made the comment that we believe that if this application goes ahead the safest entry point would be at the existing wide entrance to the Kings Cliffe Industrial site, which is under the same ownership. We understand that Highways are of the view that the entry point proposed by the applicant, which is about a ¼ mile further on the road to Kings Cliffe is suitable

However this is in a wooded area and on a bend, we have reconsidered this and believe that the proposed location is not suitable and will indeed be dangerous. Whilst Highways may have commented on this, we hope that this was not conducted by desktop research, as it really does require a visit

2. We had asked for a shop to service this new development to hopefully ensure the development is self-contained and to minimise the impact on our village. However we understand that the proposed shop would be located off the Kings Cliffe road adjacent the entrance we have referred to above. We feel that a shop in this location, rather than on the development, would increase the number of vehicles using this entrance. The Kings Cliffe – Wansford road on which this development is adjacent is the main commuter route into Kings Cliffe from Peterborough and we can see traffic pulling into this facility, increasing the number of movements at the entrance and being a further risk to viability of our village shop
